Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the none Court of _____ at _____ on the _____ day of _____, anno Domini 1 _____, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit: _____ and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)

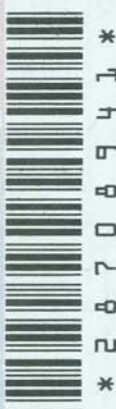
