I have been unable to find any record of Rebecca's passage to the US under her own name, either in the documents of US, Canada or UK. Family lore has it that she came over with her cousin Rose Filler Chandler, passing as sisters. But what name did she use?

The manifest for Rose Filler: Cymric, Departure: Liverpool, England, June 8, 1906; Arrival Boston: June 17, 1906 is consistent with Rebecca's report of a 1906 arrival. The parties of interest on that manifest are Rebecca's sister Esther Katz and son Isaac, as well as Rose's sister Anna/Hannah. Esther and Anna, but not Rose, are marked as coming from Volnia. I have so far no found subsequent appearances of Anna/Hannah and her husband Mordechai Lichtenberg either in the US or UK. Perhaps she remained in Poland and that Rebecca used her name.


